DAY 1: LIMA RECEPTION

Airport reception and transfer to hotel. Free time to walk around the city or rest. Accommodation in Lima

DAY 2: LIMA CITY TOUR

Breakfast at the hotel. At an appropriate time, the tour to Lima begins with a panoramic view of Huaca Pucllana, built in the 4th century AD. Next, we visit the Historic Center of Lima, where you will see the magnificent monuments and colonial buildings such as Plaza San Martín, Plaza Mayor, the Government Palace, the Archbishop's Palace, the Cathedral, among others. The tour continues to the monumental complex of San Francisco, a set of religious enclosures and beautiful legacies from the colonial era, highlighting the visit to its underground crypts known as the CATACOMBS. The tour culminates in Larcomar or hotel. Accommodation in Lima.

DAY 3: LIMA FAREWELL – ICA RECEPTION – CITY TOUR – VINEYARD

Transfers to the city of Ica in a bus conditioned for the route. We will take our tour to Tacama located in the Ica valley, one of the most representative and oldest wineries and vineyards in America that have history, architecture, technology and contact with nature. During the walk they will explain the type of vines and the vine growth process and then continue with the visit to the distillation area for a brief explanation about the production of pisco and wine and finally finish the visit in the winery to be able to appreciate the types of piscos, wines and sparkling wines made in Tacama. Accommodation in Ica.

DAY 4: HUACACHINA – TUBULARS AND SANDBOARDING – ICA FAREWELL

Breakfast at the hotel. At an opportune time we begin the journey to the Oasis of America better known as "Huacachina" where you will appreciate the impressive dunes that surround it, we will also enjoy an adventure sport in the sandpits, you can sandboard and ride in the buggies (tubular where we will take an excursion aboard the sand carts and practice with the necessary safety equipment and spend a moment of adrenaline and fun. Return to Lima, we will board a bus preparing for the route with services on board.

DAY 5: CUSCO RECEPTION

Reception at the terminal and hotel transfer. Free day to acclimatize in the city and explore its surroundings. Accommodation in Cusco.

DAY 6: CITY TOUR + VISIT TO THE 4 RUINS (Q'ENQO – PUKA PUKARA – TAMBOMACHAY & SACSAYHUAMAN)

At an appropriate time, the guided tour of the city and 4 ruins near Cusco begins. The tour begins at the Cathedral, which is important for its Architecture and canvases of Cusco Painting inside; continues through the Temple of the Sun Koricancha, on whose bases the Temple of Santo Domingo was built; Finally, we will visit the 4 surrounding ruins: Q'enqo, Puka Pukará, Tambomachay and the Sacsayhuaman Archaeological Complex. Accommodation in Cusco.

DAY 7: MACHU PICCHU TOUR

At an appropriate time, the day trip begins to visit the most important Archaeological Site in Peru, "Machu Picchu", an Inca citadel located 113 km from the city of Cusco by rail. In the morning we transfer to the train station, after a charming trip we arrive at the city of Aguas Calientes, at this point we board a tourist bus that will transport us to the archaeological park in 20 minutes. Once in the citadel, there will be enough time for the guide to show us all the natural, archaeological and cultural beauty of a unique place without equal in its kind such as the main Plaza, the Circular Tower, the Sacred Solar Clock (Intihuatana), the royal quarters, the temple of the Three Windows and the cemeteries. Return to Aguas Caliente to board the train back to Cusco. Accommodation in Cusco.

DAY 8: SACRED VALLEY TOUR + MARAS & MORAY SALINERAS

Breakfast at the hotel. At an appropriate time, we begin the tour, the first point is towards the town of Chinchero, where we will find Inca wall constructions and its colonial Church that awaits a lot of history, we will also have a small participation in the textile center. Continuing with the visit, we headed towards the famous circular cultivation terraces of Moray, this archaeological site was very important in the Inca era, and especially in agriculture. After that we will descend towards the Salineras de Maras, a picturesque place for its landscapes; Here we will visit more than 3000 salt wells, this salt was used by the Incas for consumption. After our visit to the Maras salt mines, we continue with our tour and will arrive at the city of Urubamba where we will enjoy our lunch, then we will continue the visit to the archaeological center of Ollantaytambo and Pisac, the latter two being the most important. Accommodation in Cusco.



DAY 9: RAINBOW MOUNTAIN

At an appropriate time, the adventure begins. After an introduction from our guide, we will begin our walk. The ascent will be gradual and will last approximately two hours. During the journey we will observe a variety of South American camelids such as Alpacas, Llamas, birds, lagoons, valleys, streams and snow-capped mountains. After walking approximately nine kilometers we will finally reach the Seven Colors mountain or rainbow mountain. This place is unique and magical because of the beauty it has. After enjoying the spectacular view from the highest point, a quiet moment in contact with nature. Lunch and return to Cusco. Accommodation in Cusco.

DAY 10: CUSCO FAREWELL - ROUTE OF THE SUN

Breakfast at the hotel. At an appropriate time transfer to the terminal. Very early we began the tourist circuit that will take us to the city of Puno, during the tour we make stops at tourist attractions such as Andahuaylillas and observe paintings and murals from the 16th and 17th centuries made by mestizo painters; as well as finishes and frames in gold leaf. The tour continues through Raqchi where gigantic columns built with stone bases and continued in adobe will be located. You have a buffet lunch in Sicuani. The journey continues through La Raya where the auquénids of Peru can be seen. Before arriving in Puno, we visit Pukará, the ancient ceremonial center of TIAHUANACO origin. Accommodation in Puno.

DAY 11: VISIT TO THE ISLAND OF UROS AND TAQUILE

Breakfast at the hotel. The tour begins on the shores of Lake Titicaca from where the boat ride will continue to finally visit the floating islands of the Uros, a place where reeds (common vegetation in the area) are woven by hand. Once again on board our boat, the visitor is taken to the next tourist island called Taquile, at this point they can appreciate wonderful landscapes, as well as observe the production of weaving and crafts, which are representative activities of the area. Accommodation in Puno.

DAY 12: TOUR TO THE CHULLPAS OF SILLUSTANI AND TRANSFER TO THE AIRPORT

Breakfast at the hotel. The archaeological zone of Sillustani is located 34 km from the City of Puno, in this place you can see the gigantic funerary monuments built in pre-Hispanic times; During the tour, tourists will be able to contemplate the beautiful Umayo lagoon that surrounds the archaeological center. At an appropriate time, transfers to Juliaca airport.
